
POISED FOR BUSINESS, PREPARED FOR EXCITEMENT, SOBRO IS NASHVILLE'S NEW CITY CENTER

The city's top cultural and entertainment centers, chic condos, restaurants, galleries and the legendary lower Broadway honky-tonks make the "south of Broadway" SoBro district a thriving walk/live/work/play community. Look up and you'll see the striking image of The Pinnacle above Symphony Place and the world-class Schermerhorn Symphony Center. It is the only skyscraper in the district; and, from any one of its 29 floors, tenants enjoy the best view in Nashville – an unobstructed, 360-degree birds-eye view of the city. Below, excitement is building at the emerging Music City Center convention facility and the Omni Hotel site. Other interesting building footprints are those that reach out to Nashville's music roots for inspiration, such as the keyboard shaped Country Music Hall of Fame and the (WSM) radio tower at the entrance to Bridgestone Arena. Their designs have a link to the past, but the entire location is full steam ahead to the future.

The Pinnacle's location boasts a walk score of 97 and is a short walk from other downtown destinations. Tenants and customers also enjoy easy driving access. Just two blocks from The Pinnacle is the Korean War Veterans Memorial Bridge, with access to the interstate leading to every corridor of the city.
